

## **Essential information for attending church in person**

***Please read all of this leaflet before attending church.***

Please ask for our Risk Assessment if you would like see it.


**You MUST NOT ATTEND if you have had COVID SYMPTOMS or been ask to self isolate. You must also follow government guidance for self-isolation if you have attended certain foreign countries.**



1. **Face masks** continue to be a legal requirement for everyone over the age of 11



7. The collective administration of the **Lord's supper** is permitted with careful distribution by the deacons. Currently held, usually on the first Sunday of the month.



2. We have kept a **designated seating area for social distancing**, along the left wall of the church building.


Everyone who is exempt from wearing a mask must sit in this area. We also ask that anyone who is unvaccinated use this area. It is also available for anyone who feels more comfortable in a socially distanced section.



8. Please bring your **own Bible**. The church ones are not available at the moment.



9. No **offering** will be taken. Those who would like to give in this way will be able to do so via a box available in the foyer. Otherwise please give online direct.



3. We have **increased seating capacity**. This is possible because the building is well ventilated, people attending wear masks, and are not in face to face contact. We recommend leaving at least one seat between yourself and other people outside of your family.



10. **Toilet facilities** are available. Hand dryers are permitted or the use of paper towels. *Children* under the age of 11 must not use the toilets unattended. If you use the toilet, please **spray** the seat after use with the sanitiser provided, as well as following hand-washing hygiene. If paper towels or spray is not available, please inform a steward.



4. **Contact tracing** We need to keep a note of who attends, and a contact number if they are a visitor.



5. **Hand Sanitising, outdoor socialising** if the weather permits, and the one-way system continue to be in place.



11. **Covid Symptoms**. Please let us know immediately, at any time within 14 days of your visit, if Covid19 symptoms develop so we can take necessary steps to let others you were in contact with know.



6. **Quiet singing** is still only permitted if you are wearing a mask.
