NEW FOODBANK APP


Along with many South Wales Foodbanks we have seen a big drop in public food donations, down over 30% compared to 2 years ago. One new initiative we have introduced to support donations is the "Bank the Food" phone app. BanktheFood is FREE and very simple to use. Download the app from your app store here and follow the instructions to get started.

Find and follow Monmouth and District Foodbank. Then the app will send you a helpful 'ping' with a reminder of your food banks' needs when you are shopping in your local supermarket. It will also then show you exactly what items are needed and you can leave any your purchase in food bank's collection box at the end of your shopping trip, or in our foyer.

The food bank will also be alerted via the app of your (anonymous) donation making it easier for your food bank to track and locate items they really need. Download the app from:



SRI LANKA

Sasha is 18 (name changed for security). She became a Christian when she was 12 years old after she experienced a miraculous healing with her sister and aunt and then Sasha herself was healed from a sickness after being prayed for. She faced immediate opposition from her father, coming to a head towards the end of last year after her father demanded to search her bag and found gospel tracts which she would often hand out whenever she got the chance to share the gospel with someone. He beat her and warned that he would kill her if he ever saw her near a church again. Sasha's father then grabbed the gospels out of the bag and forced her to burn them. Since then, her father checks her bag whenever she goes out of the house.

Despite this abuse and opposition, Sasha remains resolute in her faith, although she has to keep her faith hidden from her father, and can't evangelise as openly as she once did.

Pray:- Pray for Sasha, and all the other women and girls who have to keep their faith secret and who fear violence and repression from persecutors – particularly those who live in fear of their family members. Pray that they will see change.
